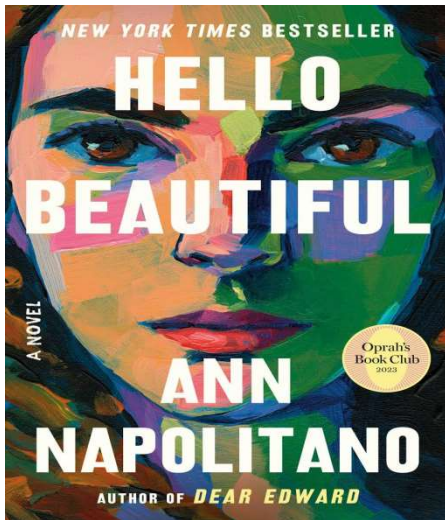


Book Review
